

SYU Cup 7-a-side Football Competition Regulation

Purpose:	Through the competition, participants will be able: 1. To learn from each other and to improve individual skills in a competitive environment. 2. To develop friendships and enrich University life.
Date:	6 April 2024 (Saturday) 09:00 – 16:00
Venue:	Chinese International School (Football Pitch)
Eligibility:	Current HKSYU students and staff. Each team may register: - a maximum of 12 players, and the mixed-gender format is available. - a maximum of 4 members from SYU Football Team 2023-2024.
Format of the competition:	(1) Teams will be drawn into two groups, and a single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary. (2) Teams are ranked by total points. Three points for a win, one point for a draw, zero point for a loss, disqualification or walk over. (3) If two teams have won the same points, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher; If three or more teams have won the same points, the number of goals difference will be used to determine the placing (Goal difference = Goal scored – Goal lost); If still tied, the number of total goals scored will be used to determine the placing; If still tied, a toss-up will be adopted. (4) The top rank in each group will qualify for the Champion Game. The second rank in each group will qualify for the Bronze Match. (5) 30 minutes for each match.
Quota:	8 entries (enrollment on a first-come-first-served basis)
Reporting time:	Participating teams and a minimum of 7 players shall report to the Tournament Committee 10 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
Referee:	Football Team members will be appointed as referees by the Tournament Committee.
Balls:	Balls will be provided by the Tournament Committee
Prizes:	Winner, 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd runner up.
Enrollment deadline:	27 March 2024 (Wednesday)
Remark:	This activity will be recorded in the Award and Co-curricular Achievement Transcript (ACAT) & apply as one of the eligible activities for Dr. Li Dak Sum Outstanding Whole Person Development Awards.
