

SYU Cup Volleyball Competition Regulation

Purpose:	Through the competition, participants will be able: 1. To learn from each other and to improve individual skills in a competitive environment. 2. To develop friendships and enrich University life.
Date & Time:	20 & 27 March 2025 (Thursday), 18:00 – 22:00
Venue:	RLG506 Multi-purpose Hall, Research Complex
Eligibility:	Current HKSYU students and staff. Each team may register: – a maximum of 12 players. – a maximum of 5 players from the SYU Volleyball Teams 2024-2025, with a limit of 2 male players from the SYU Men’s Volleyball Teams per team.
Format of the competition:	(1) Teams will be drawn into two groups, and a single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary. The top two teams in each group will qualify for the final. A single round-robin system will be adopted in the final round. One set with 25 points will be adopted in each match.
	(2) 2 points shall be awarded for a win, 1 point for a loss, and 0 point for abstaining or disqualification. If 2 teams have won with the same points, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher. If 3 or more teams have won the same points, the ranking will be established by the total points won in each match, with greater differences ranked higher. If still equal, the ranking will be established by the total points lost in each match, with smaller differences ranked higher.
	(3) Net height: 2.24m.
Quota:	8 entries (enrollment on a first-come-first-served basis)
Reporting time:	Participating teams and a minimum of 6 players shall report to the Tournament Committee 10 minutes prior to the scheduled time.
Referee:	Volleyball Team members will be appointed as referees by the Tournament Committee.
Balls:	The “Mikasa V300W” is adopted as the official ball of the competition.
Prizes:	Winner, 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd runner up.
Enrollment deadline:	13 March 2025 (Thursday) 17:00
Remark:	This activity will be recorded in the Award and Co-curricular Achievement Transcript (ACAT) & apply as one of the eligible activities for Dr. Li Dak Sum Outstanding Whole Person Development Awards.
