	Scholarship for Year 1 University Studies	Scholarship for Year 2-4 University Studies
Application Notes	Student applicants must be a Secondary Six full-time student who will be applying university studies in the current year and is nominated by their secondary school. Each secondary school can nominate up to one eligible student and submit the application <u>online</u> .	Applicants must be a full-time university student who will continue their Year 2/3/4 full-time bachelor's study at one of the Hong Kong's universities# in September 2025 and is the first undergraduate amongst three generations in the family . Eligible applicants are invited to submit application <u>online</u> .
Eligibility	<p>The nominee must be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The first-generation university student from his/her family if he/she receives a university admission offer (i.e. his/her grandparents and parents do not hold any degree from any university); 2. A Secondary Six full-time student attending a local secondary school, including government-aided and government secondary schools, aided special schools, Direct Subsidy Scheme schools or private secondary schools; 3. A student who is a candidate of <u>HKDSE in 2025</u>; 4. Academically outstanding and holding a full-time undergraduate programme admission offer from a local university# (proof of university admission offer to be submitted later); 5. A local student*** (e.g. holder of HKID Card (Permanent) or Permit for Proceeding to Hong Kong and Macau (One-way Permit)); 6. Aged 25 below (i.e. born on or after 1 September 2000); and 7. Proactively participating in community services. 	<p>Student applicants must be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The first-generation university student from his/her family (i.e. his/her grandparents and parents do not hold any degree from any university) to study at one of the Hong Kong's universities#, and is able to provide one of the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The panel will assess students' performance (e.g. communications capability, logical thinking, achievement and commitment to social service etc.) at the interview to select the awarded students. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Interested schools must complete the Letter of Intent for Nomination through Google form on or before 28 May 2025 (4:59 pm). HKCSS will provide a link to online application system and first-time login password to school's contact person via email. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Eligible applicants should submit application via online system (https://fgu.hkcsslol.org.hk/student) before 11:59 pm on 17 July 2025. <u>Late submissions will not be accepted.</u> 2. HKCSS will coordinate all successful applications and verify the information submitted. 3. After the first-round assessment, shortlisted students will be invited to the interview. The applications can be considered unsuccessful if applicants do not receive any invitation for interview. 4. Interview will be held in November 2025, and the results will be announced in December. Awarded students will be notified.

2. The nomination should be submitted **via the [online application system](#) on or before 3 July 2025 (4:59 pm). Late submissions will not be accepted.**
 3. **Applicants with university admission offer will have to submit the proof^ and join the first interview via an online platform.**
 4. Shortlisted students after the first interview will be invited to attend the Interview Day. Selection will be conducted by the Link University Scholarship Selection Panel. The applications can be considered unsuccessful if applicants do not receive any invitation for interview. Interview will be held in November 2025, and the results will be announced in December. Awarded students and the secondary school will be notified.
