

# SYU Cup Volleyball Competition Regulation

Purpose:	Through the competition, participants will be able to: 1. learn from each other and improve their individual skills in a competitive environment; 2. develop friendships and enrich university life.	
Date & Time:	13 & 20 March 2026 (Friday), 18:00 – 22:00	
Venue:	RLG506 Multi-purpose Hall, Research Complex	
Eligibility:	Current HKSYU students and staff members Each team may register: – a maximum of 12 players; – a maximum of 5 players in total from the 2025–2026 SYU Volleyball Teams, with no more than 2 players from the 2025–2026 SYU Men’s Volleyball Team.	
Format of the competition:	(1)	Teams will be drawn into four groups, and a single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary round. The top team in each group will qualify for the final round.
	(2)	One set of 25 points will be played in each match.
	(3)	A single round-robin system will be adopted in the final round.
	(4)	2 points shall be awarded for a win, 1 point for a loss, and 0 points for abstaining or disqualification. If 2 teams finish with the same number of points, the winner of the match between them will be ranked higher. If 3 or more teams finish with the same number of points, the ranking will be determined by the total points won in all matches, with greater differences ranked higher. If still equal, the ranking will be determined by the total points conceded in all matches, with fewer points conceded ranked higher.
	(5)	Net height: 2.24 m.
Quota:	12 entries (first-come, first-served basis)	
Reporting time:	Participating teams, with a minimum of 6 players, shall report to the Tournament Committee 10 minutes prior to the scheduled match time.	
Referee:	Members of the Volleyball Teams will be appointed as referees by the Tournament Committee.	
Balls:	The “Mikasa V300W” will be used as the official match ball.	
Prizes:	Champion, 1st runner-up, 2nd runner-up and 3rd runner-up.	
Enrollment deadline:	<b>3 March 2026 (Tuesday)</b>	
Remark:	This activity will be recorded in the Award and Co-curricular Achievement Transcript (ACAT) & apply as one of the eligible activities for Dr. Li Dak Sum Outstanding Whole Person Development Awards.
